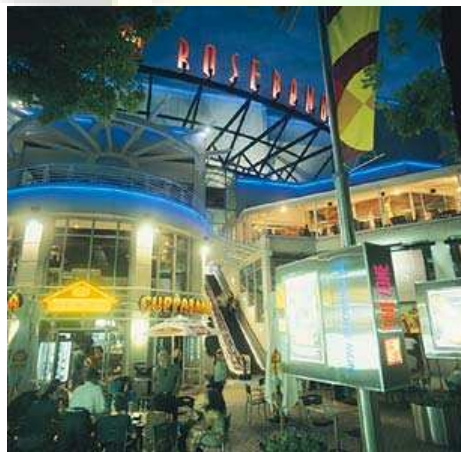

Johannesburg

From Pretoria:

- Take the M1 South
- Take Glenhove offramp
- Turn right into Glenhove Road
- Pass 3 traffic lights
- Pass Oxford Road intersection
- Keep in your extreme right lane
- At the next traffic light, turn right into Cradock Avenue
- Pass 2 traffic lights
- Proceed straight, the lane curves to the left
- You can enter the boom gates to The Zone
- You can either park in the open parking on Ground floor or you can proceed down the ramp into Parking levels P1 and P2 for ample parking

From the South:

- Take the M1 North
- Take Glenhove offramp
- Turn left into Glenhove offramp
- Pass 3 traffic lights
- Pass Oxford Road intersection
- Keep in your extreme right lane
- At the next traffic light, turn right into Cradock Avenue
- Pass 2 traffic lights

Tournament Format

Sport Dress

Each player preferably to wear a Jogging suit (Top and Bottom), with a sport t-shirt on the inside.

Qualification Games

Each player or team will play qualification matches.

- In the Men's Singles only 64 players will qualify.
- In the Men's Doubles only 32 teams will qualify.
- In the Ladies Singles only 16 players will qualify.
- In the Ladies Doubles only 8 teams will qualify.
- In the Junior Singles only 32 players will qualify.
- In the Junior Doubles only 16 teams will qualify.

Each Player/ team must win 5 games in a row. First team to score 5 is the winner of the game. All games to be played on Garlando Tables

Ranking

Qualified players & teams will be grouped as follows.

Each Player/ team plays each other 1 game only in their group. First team to score 7 is the winner of the game. All games to be played on Garlando Tables

Elimination Matches
